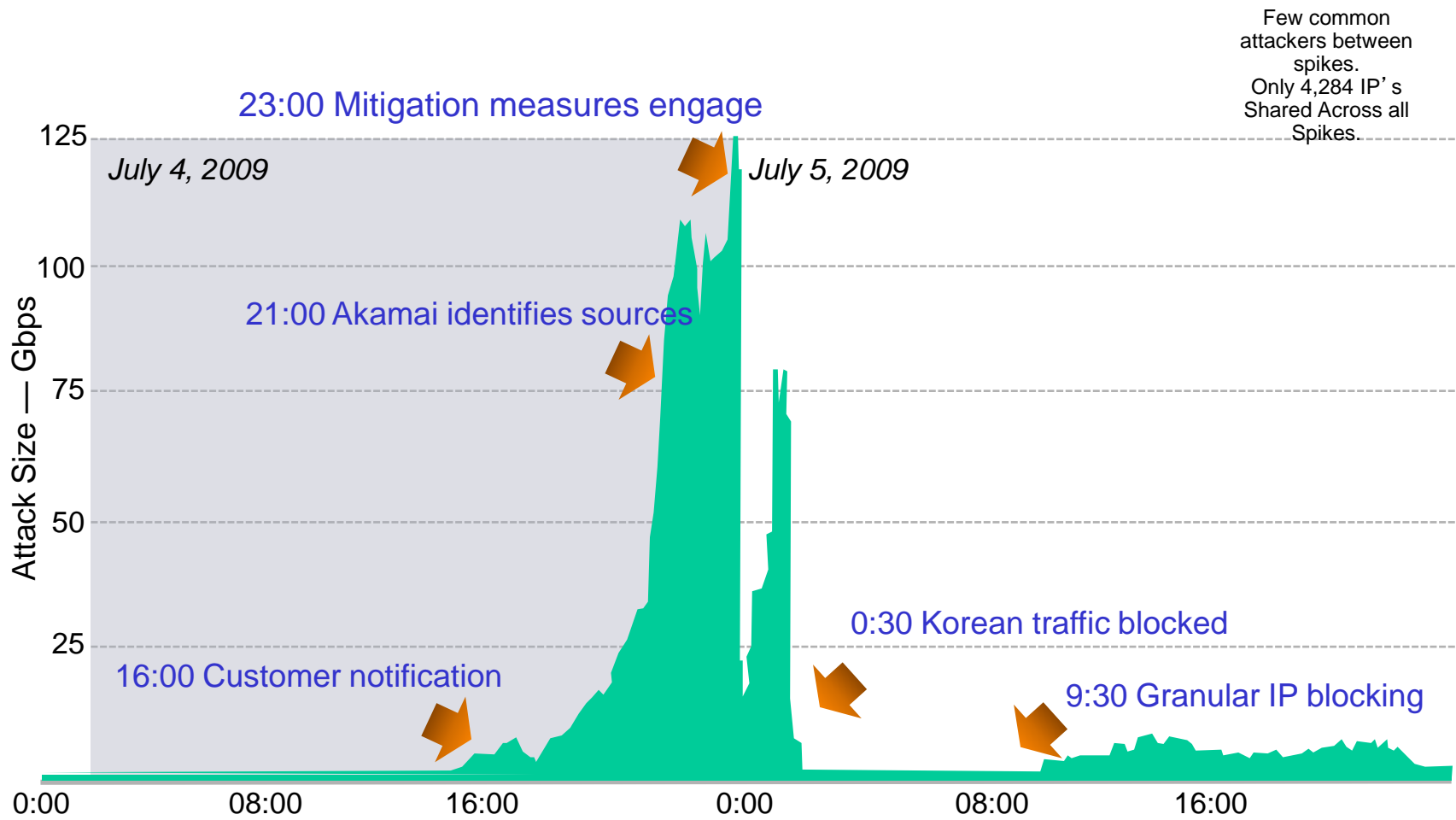

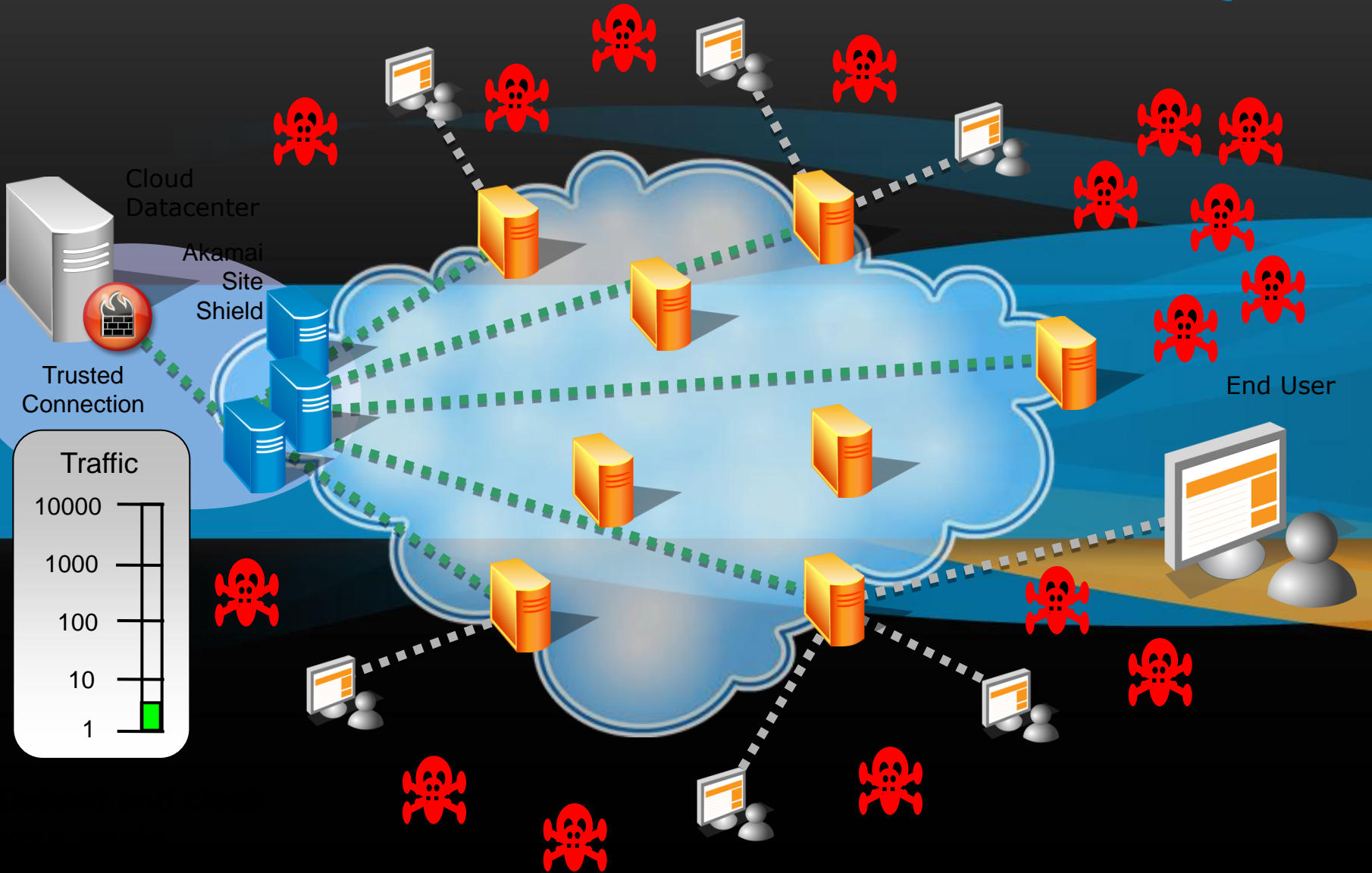


# Web Site With Akamai



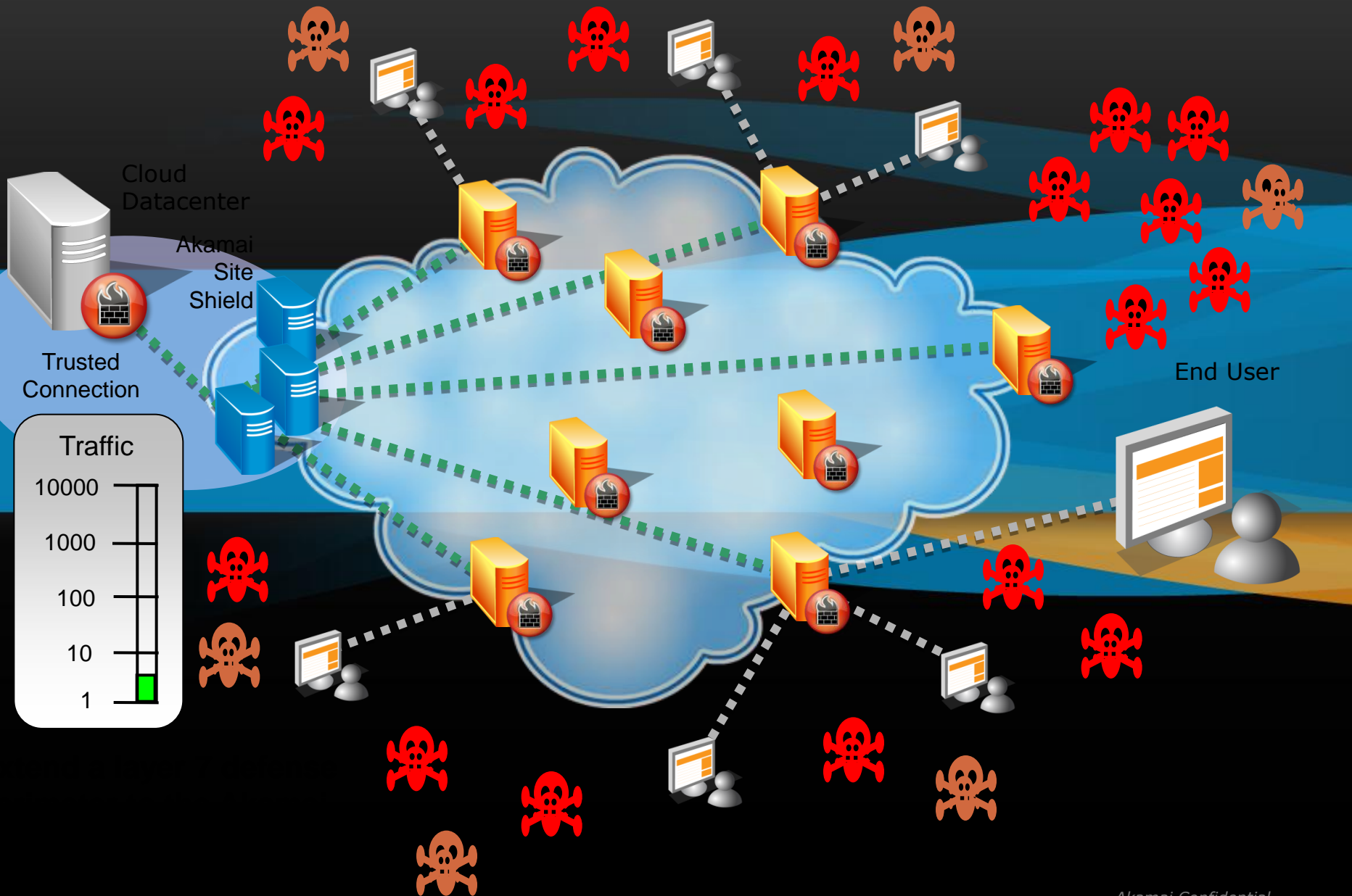


# Web Site with Akamai Site Shield
